

- •39% of teens & 59% of young adults have sent or posted sexually suggestive images or videos
- *20% of teens & 33% of young adults have sent/posted nude or semi-nude images of themselves
- •38% of teens & 46% of young adults say it is common for nudes to be shared with people other than the
- ■By 15 children were more likely to have seen online pornography
- •65% of 15-16 year olds report seeing pornography
- •Children were as likely to stumble across pornography via a pop up as to search for it deliberately
- Psychological / Emotional Being hooked up to devices has an overwhelming impact on childrens anxiety levels



Online Bullying Anti Bullying Week

- It can start off as a joke and spiral out of control.
- It can be very **hurtful & upsetting & <u>IS WRONG</u>**
- Adults and young people think that because its online it $% \left(x\right) =\left(x\right)$ makes them ${\bf Anonymous}$ and wont be ${\bf Found}.$
- It now almost always involves 'The Camera'
- Mostly through Apps & Closed Groups (Discord -Street Chat)
- Revenge



What Should Adults Do?

- · Listen & take child seriously
- Make sure child is and feels safe
- Don't overreact
- Encourage child not to retaliate
- Gather facts & save the evidence
- Get the child to help solve the problem
- Teach self-esteem & resilience
- Bring in school officials if there is a "nexus" with school
- Encourage child to reach out to friends
- Encourage Courage: "Be a friend, not a bystander"



Indecent Images of Children

The term 'sexting' is used to describe the sending and receiving of sexually explicit photos, messages and video clips, by text, email or posting them on social networking sites. It's increasingly done by young people who send images and messages to their friends, partners, or even strangers they meet online.

Sexing: Sexing is sending, receiving, or forwarding sexually explicit messages, photographs or images, Indecent Image of a Child'Is not defined by Isw, the decision of whether an image is indecent is left to the police, CPS and the jury.

Child: Anyone Under the age of 18 year Age of Criminal Responsibility: 10 years of Age

So What Are the Risk of Sending 'Inappropriate Selfies'?

- Humiliation, Guilt, Shame, Anger and Self-Blame—which can lead to ongoing <u>emotional distress</u> <u>withdrawal from school and family life</u> and in severe cases, <u>self-harm and suicidal thoughts</u>
- <u>Damage to Digital Tattoo</u>—it may impact on their reputation and performance at school, as well as employment opportunities in the future
- <u>Criminal Charges</u> and penalties—it can be a crime when it involves creating, possessing and/or sharing sexualised images of people under 18 years. <u>Sex Offender Register and/or DBS</u>

So What Are the Risk of Sending 'Inappropriate Selfies' Cont?

Inappropriate Selfie = Sexy Selfie = Sexting = Indecent Images of Children Risks - Legal & Non Legal

(Being Aware of Local Implications & Cultural Implications)

- Creating, distributing or possessing an indecent image of a child against the law (LEGAL)
- Emotional and psychological damage (NON-LEGAL)
- · Reputational Damage Digital Tattoo (NON-LEGAL)
- Online manipulation/extortion (NON-LEGAL)
- Outcome 21 (New UK Law NON-LEGAL/ LEGAL)





The Legal Consequences

Outcome 21

- Every 'crime' recorded on police systems has to be assigned an outcome from a predefined list of outcome codes.
 January 2016 the Home Office blunched a new outcome code (Outcome 21) to help formalise the discretion available to the police when handling crimes such as youth produced sound limagery.

Outcome 21 states:
Further investigation, resulting from the crime report, which could provide evidence sufficient to support formal action being taken against the suspect is not in the public interest. This is a police decision.

This means that even though a young person has broken the law and the police could provide evidence that they have done so, the police can record that they chose not to take further action as it was not in the public interest.

DBS certificates
It is not possible to categorically say that an incident of youth produced sexual
imagery recorded on police systems with Dutcome 21 would never be disclosed on
Therefore a 16 year old who is investigated
But not charged or cautioned will have the investigation
Shown on a DBS Disclosure until they are 27
