We have been invited to send along 4 pupils (2 girls and 2 boys) from Year 4 to take part in a Boccia Event on Thursday 23rd November from 1:00-3:15pm. It will be held at The Sennocke Centre, Sevenoaks School.

We would like to invite your child to take part in the Boccia Event. They will need to wear school PE kit/school tracksuit and either plimsolls or trainers. We are particularly looking to invite children who have not taken part in a school team event. The event will be run with the support of 5 pupils from Valence School, a local school for children and young people with physical disabilities and complex medical needs.

There may not be a member of school staff at the event so we will need volunteers to help. Please indicate when registering if you are able to volunteer to help supervise the children. Parents are welcome to stay and we would be extremely grateful if a parent would be prepared to oversee the pupils at the event if necessary.

In order for us to take part we are looking for parental support in providing lifts. We request that if you are unable to drop or collect your child at the venue that you make your own arrangements with another family to transport your child and include the name of the person on the form. They will need to leave school by 12:30pm.

There is NO cost for this event but parents do need to advise us if they **do not** wish their child to participate in this event.
