2023 Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Letter for Palmer Class

Welcome to the Autumn Term 2 at Shoreham Village School. We hope you have all had a restful half term break.

Reading

We ask that reading records be handed into school each day so that they can be used as a means of communication with your child's class teacher. Please can I ask that you are reading with your child every day for around 10 minutes. Reading records will be checked daily, as they also provide a valuable link between home and school. When a child has read 100 times with accompanying signatures, they will be awarded a book of their choice.

Homework

Homework will be set online on a **Friday** and collected in on a **Wednesday**. You can find the homework on Shoreham school website under Palmer Class. At the front of your child's homework book are a list of common exception words, it would be helpful if your child could be practising these. It may not always be possible for your child to complete all of the homework set, but please encourage your child to finish what they are capable of, and then spend some time reading **each day**. It is important that the children get into a routine of reading instructions and questions for themselves and to have a good attempt at the work set. A relaxed discussion with your child about work that they are stuck on can often be beneficial, providing your child does not feel under pressure. Please continue to use our Mathletics program at home as well. We will send the log in details home shortly.

PE

PE will be on a Monday and Friday afternoon. Please ensure that your child is wearing their PE kit into school, which they will then wear throughout the day.

General

Please ensure that your child has a named water bottle and that all personal clothing and items are labelled. Fruit is provided free of charge for all pupils, however if children bring their own snack please could you ensure that it is a healthy one.
