### LOVE TO DANCE PERFORMANCE –TUESDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 4:00PM FULL PERFORMANCE

Further to the previous letter regarding the dance performances, we have now got the final information for you.

# What they need for Love to Dance: PLEASE ENSURE ALL COSTUME PARTS ARE NAMED Costumes for Boogie Woogie Woogie!

### Girls

- Plain white polo shirt
- Cycling shorts to wear under costume
- Black jazz shoes or black plimsolls (No white soled or white edged shoes are allowed on the stage)
- White ankle socks
- (skirt and neck tie to be provided by school)
- Hair in a high ponytail where possible.
- Hair brush

#### **Boys:**

- blue jeans if you have some if not blue joggers.
- Black jazz shoes or black plimsolls (No white soled or white edged shoes are allowed on stage)
- T-shirt to be provided by school
- Hair brush

If possible, please could you come with hair ready for the dance and with foundation on. The foundation is needed due to the effect stage lighting has. It is a good idea to wear a tracksuit with a zip top, so hair and make-up doesn't get spoilt by taking a jumper off.

## <u>Please could they bring their costume parts to school for an in-school dress rehearsal at Dance Club on</u> Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March

### Dress rehearsal on Tuesday 12th March

This has now been confirmed to be from 9:15-10:00 on stage. We have been lucky to be given ¾ of an hour to rehearse on stage as we have asked for a morning slot. We will aim to meet at the Stage Door at 9:00am. Please could you indicate whether you would be able to help with lifts to The Stag theatre for this. As it is first thing in the morning, we will go directly to the theatre and meet there rather than into school. Please could you

















indicate if you are able to help with lifts for this and also if anybody would be able to stay and help at the theatre. We would then need to return to school. I anticipate us being ready to leave around 10:30am.

### Performance on Tuesday 12th march

We would be grateful if you would be able to take and collect your child to and from the Stag Theatre for the following times:

- Leave school by 2:40pm to arrive at the theatre by 3.15pm. (If you have a sibling who is not performing and you would need to collect them from school, to help with lifts, they may on this occasion leave school early.)
- The children will need to be collected from the Stage Door at 6:45pm.

Children will need to bring a healthy packed tea, healthy snack, something small to do (no electrical devices) and a bottle of water. Please don't bring fizzy drinks, foods containing nuts or glass bottles.

### Reminder

There are two performances on this day, but as we are only performing one dance, we will be at the theatre for the whole of the 4pm performance and then we will be the opening dance of the 6:30pm performance and then leaving with collection at 6:45pm from the Stage Door.

Thank you for your help and support in making this possible. Please complete the online form by <u>Wednesday</u> <u>6<sup>th</sup> March</u> confirming who will be collecting your child after the performance and details for the dress rehearsal.

We request that if you are unable to drop or collect your child at the venue that you make your own arrangements with another family to transport your child.
