## Cameron Class Trip to Knole Park - Wednesday 13th March

We have booked a Cameron class trip to Knole Park on Wednesday 13th March, to support our learning from last term about the Tudors – local history.

Knole was once a grand Tudor palace. Students can follow in the footsteps of the Tudors as they explore this magnificent 600-year-old house and its courtyards. In this hands-on session students will discover how the Tudors once lived.

We enquired about hiring a coach, however, as you aware this is a costly way of transporting the children and therefore resulted in the trip being too expensive (adding an additional £20 each child to the trip). We would be grateful if parents could drop the children off in the car park at Knole Park at 9:45am, ready for our session to start at 10.00am please. You will not be able to access the car park before 9.45am as they are opening early for us at this time. If you are unable to transport your child for this trip please could you make your own arrangements with another family please and detail travel arrangements in the trip form on scopay. Please contact the school office if you are struggling to make transport arrangements and we will try to put you in touch with another family.

The visit will consist of the following activities:

Object Handling – handle replica artefacts (as well as a couple of real ones) and learn how they were used. Showrooms Tour – discover Knole's Showrooms on a guided tour that will take your group through what life would have been like.

Costumes – learn about what different people would have worn in Tudor times and try on our bespoke collection of costumes.

Park Walk – take a guided walk in the park and find out why Henry VIII liked Knole so much.

The sessions finish at 2.30pm and we are kindly asking if you could pick your child up at that time, or make arrangements for them to be picked up by another parent. You will not need to return to school.

On the day, children will need to bring a small snack and a packed lunch plus their water bottle in a named small back pack to make it easier to carry. We are a nut free school so please ensure that you do not include any nuts. School uniform and school caps must be worn please.

















The cost of this trip will be £6.00. All payments must be made online at www.scopay.com/shorehamvillage

You are required to tick the consent box for this event, this will give permission for your child to attend and for the adult in charge of the party to give consent on your behalf for any urgent medical treatment, including anaesthetic to be given. You will also need to indicate who will be transporting your child to the event.

We will require a volunteer to help with this event. If you would like to assist, then please indicate via the form and we will contact you to confirm your place via email.

Please register by <u>Wednesday 6th March</u>. If we do not hear from you by this date then we will assume that your child is not able to participate.
